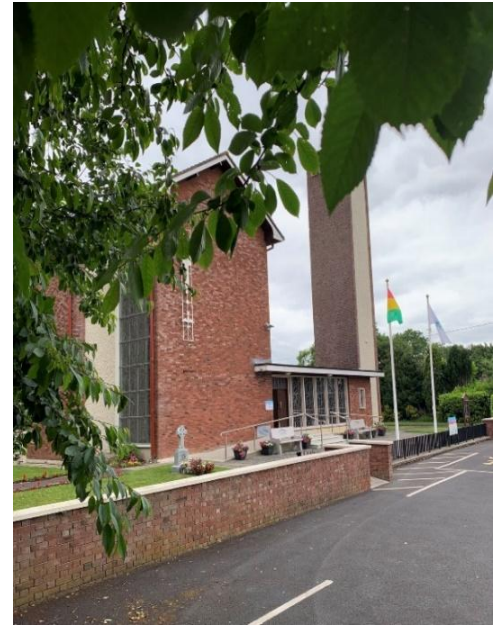

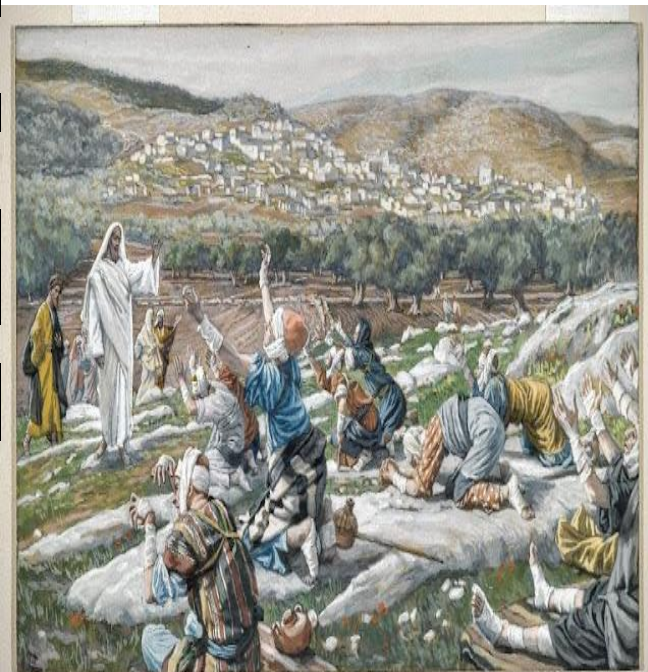

Sunday next is **Mission Sunday** and we hold our annual collection. All monies collected go to Missio Ireland.

How does Missio Ireland work?

- 1.** Missio Ireland is the Irish branch of the Pontifical Mission Societies, which is the Holy Father's official charity for overseas mission.
- 2.** All projects are submitted to Pontifical Mission Societies Rome, where they are vetted.
- 3.** All Mission Sunday collections in Ireland come to Missio Ireland.
- 4.** All funds are audited.
- 5.** Missio Ireland makes known to Rome how much we have available for projects in a given year.
- 6.** Missio Ireland then receives projects from PMS Rome that matches the amount available.
- 7.** Money is sent direct from Ireland to the Nunico in the recipient country, he forwards the money to the bishop of the diocese and he sends them to the project recipient
