SEASON OF CREATION 2022

The Burning Bush
Ex 3:1-12

The logo for the Season of Creation 2022 is taken from the image of Moses before the burning bush in Exodus 3:1-12.

(Taken from the Celebration Guide) 'Today, the prevalence of unnatural fires are a sign of the devastating effects that climate change has on the most vulnerable of our planet. Creation cries out as forests crackle, animals

flee, and people are forced to migrate due to the fires of injustice.

On the contrary, the fire that called to Moses as he tended the flock on Mt Horeb did not consume or destroy the bush. This flame of the Spirit revealed God's presence. The holy fire affirmed that God heard the cries of all who suffered and promised to be with us as we follow in faith to our deliverance from injustice. During the Season of

Creation, this symbol calls us to listen to the voice of creation, and faithfully respond through worship, repentance and action.

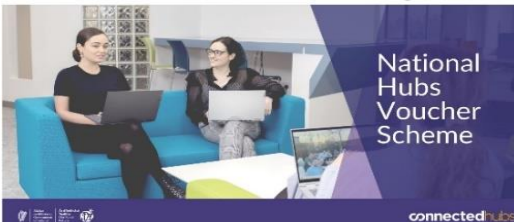
