Thomas was stabbed with a
spear in India during one of his
mission trips to establish church
in the sub-continent

Jude was killed with arrows when
he refused to deny his faith in
Christ

Matthias the apostle chosen to
replace the traitor Judas Iscariot,
was stoned and then beheaded.

Paul was tortured and then
beheaded by the evil emperor
Nero at Rome in AD 67. Paul
endured a lengthy imprisonment
which allowed him to write his
many epistles to the churches he
had formed throughout the
Roman Empire. These letters,
which taught many of the
foundational Doctrine of
Christianity, formed a large
portion of the New Testament.
