Streams of Income.

Parishes have Charitable Status. Revenue in Ireland have granted charities a facility to claim money back on donations. If you donate €250 or more in a year, including your weekly donation, we can claim a bonus from revenue, with your permission. This has no implications for your tax situation. Years back the donor could claim tax back for themselves. This is no longer possible. If you have already filled a form for us to claim from revenue, we need you to sign an updated form which will suffice for five years. You may wish to come on board for the first time. If you have any queries on this process please get in touch with us for clarification. For the parish this is another stream of income, made easy by the revenue in the light of your generosity.
