An exert from Seamus Cullens website" In 1812 Thomas Wogan Browne died at 'Castlebrown' and the property passed to his brother General Michael Wogan Browne who was a famous military officer on the continent. The following year he sold

'Castlebrown' to the Jesuits who established a college in the building. The Jesuits restored the building to its original name of Clongowes Wood and appointed Fr. Kenny as the first rector. The college opened in 1814 as a boarding school for boys from mainly well to do Catholic families. It brought considerable benefits to the area both commercially and in the area of employment."
