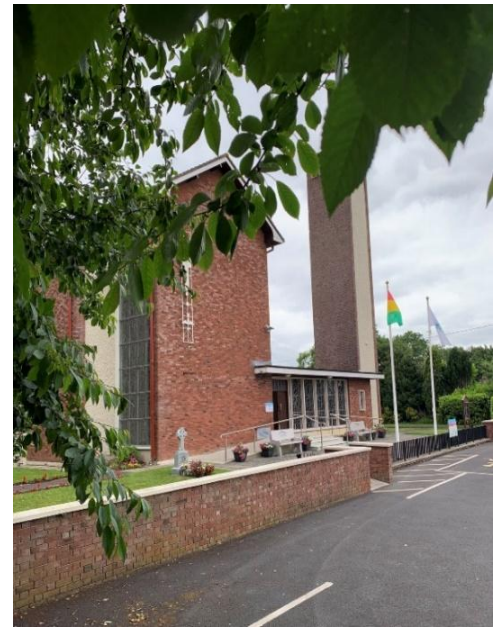

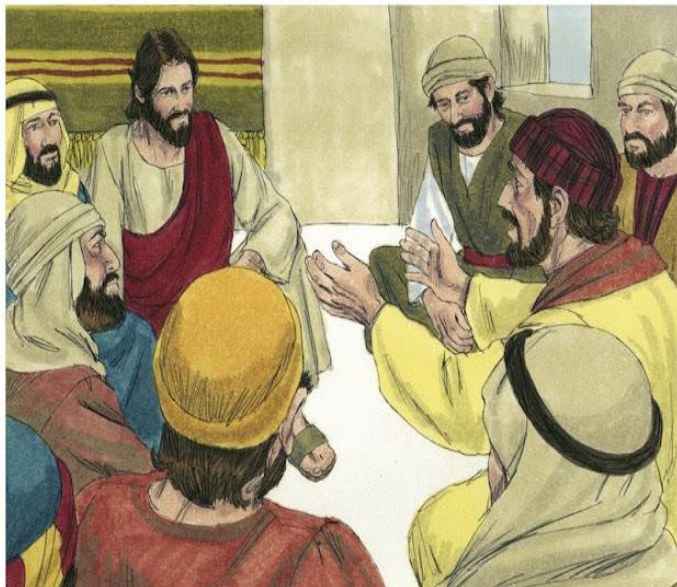

**Pope Leo XIV's early
writings to be released in
English.** The English edition
of "Freedom Under Grace" is
set to hit bookshelves in
September, bringing
together homilies,
addresses, messages, and
letters written by Fr. Robert
Francis Prevost during his
years as Prior General of the
Order of Saint Augustine.

A book containing the early
public writings by Fr. Robert
Francis Prevost—now Pope
Leo XIV—will be released on
September 15 for the first
time in English.

The volume, entitled
"Freedom Under Grace:
Reflections on the Spiritual
Tradition That Formed Me,"
will be published by Image
Books, an imprint of the
Penguin Random House
Christian Publishing Group.
